



Harlequin Quilt  
 Partial Seam Construction  
 Log Cabin Block Variation

Cut and assemble materials:

Block 1: One 2.5" black square (provided) and  
 Four 2.5" x 4" jewel tone rectangles: Two lighter and two darker of the same tone.

Block 2: One 2.5" gray square (provided)  
 Four 2.5" x 4" black rectangles

Make the two blocks using partial seam construction.

Quarter inch seams. Finger press seams open during construction then press with iron when completed.

A. With right sides together, line up the top and right edges of the patch 1 and sew from the center of the black square to the end of the patch.

Flip the patch right side out and press. (This is the step to pay attention to so all the blocks are oriented in the same direction.)

B. Sew the patches to the center square in sequence alternating light and dark patches. Flip and press.

C. After patch 4 is sewn, complete the patch 1 partial seam.

Use jewel tone indicated in the upper right corner so we are assured to have a variety of colors.  
 Or other bright jewel tone. Light and darker.

We will have 36 colored blocks and 36 black blocks.

The quilt uses 36 colored blocks and 25 black blocks.

The extra black blocks can be cut diagonally to make the setting side blocks.

Or just assemble in rows alternating color and black blocks.
