

Day 1: Fearless Free Motion Quilting, An Introduction to Free Motion Quilting - If you would like to learn to free motion quilt in a *supportive* and *fun* atmosphere, then join me and learn how to begin *quilting your own projects* at home with your home machine. Free motion quilting allows you to work directly on

your own projects with *little or no marking* and no stencils. We will begin working on paper and make lots of mistakes there-then we will begin to play on fabric samples with confidence. This is not as hard as you think!

Day 2: Fearless Fills and Frills - You will make your starter sample on Day 1 and then add fill and frills to that piece on Day 2.
