Some Great New Fabrics at Rainbow Resource Co. in Albion – Charlene

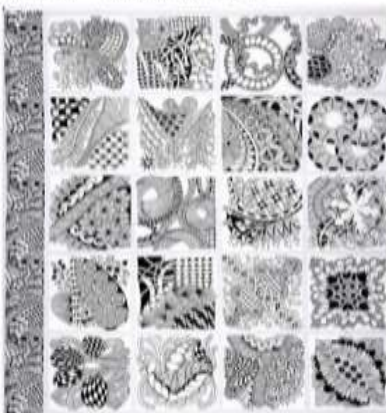
Many of you may not know this, but there is a fabric store in Albion! Rainbow Resource Co. (rainbowresourceco.com) is located in my home. I have some unique fabrics and lots of precut fat quarters, half-yards and yards sorted by topic.



I am also an avid dyer – I love to hand-dye laces and trims.

I just got in some fabulous fabric (shown here) from Marcus Fabrics – it's their Color Mood digital print line – in a rainbow print, a blue and green print, and in a wonderful tan and gray print. \$13 per yard. Think how great this would look in a border – and no piecing!!

And I got this wonderful Benartex Tangle Time panel – based on the Zentangles craze. The squares are 7 1/2"; the border is 3 1/2". It's designed to let you color with pencils, pens or markers to create your own fabric. This 1 yard panel is \$12.50
