Quilts for Fire Victims - Sharon L

We are collecting quilts to distribute to fire victims. These quilts can be any size. Bring any quilts you would like to donate to Sunday's meeting.

If you have quilt tops you would like to donate, I would be happy to quilt them, but I ask that you piece the backing. I need a minimum margin of 3" top and bottom and 1 1/2" on each side. If you need fabric for backings, come "shop" in my stash! I've got lots of backing fabric! The club will provide the batting and a label that says "This quilt was made especially for you by the Ocean Wave Quilters...."

Our plan is to take quilts to both Kerrie's Quilting in Lakeport (Kerrie has distributed quilts to fire victims for the past 4 years) and to the Grapevine Quilters of Mendocino County in Ukiah (to whom we donated quilts last year). Both groups have procedures to make sure the quilts go to families that have suffered losses from the fires.

We'll also be making quilts on Sew/Service Sunday on September 23rd. Depending on how many quilts come in prior to that, we may go ahead and send quilts over to Lakeport and Ukiah - the quilts we make on the 23rd will then be held in our closets until needed either for Warm Welcome or Chaplains - or for more fire victims (because, sadly, we know fire season isn't over).
