

Roman Square Blockette

This is going to be a SCRAPPY Roman Square – a “use your stash” project.

For each block, you will need:

- 3 different fabrics – prints or solids – whatever colors you want, but try not to have them all the same value - cut them into $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
- Black fabric (provided) – cut into one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.

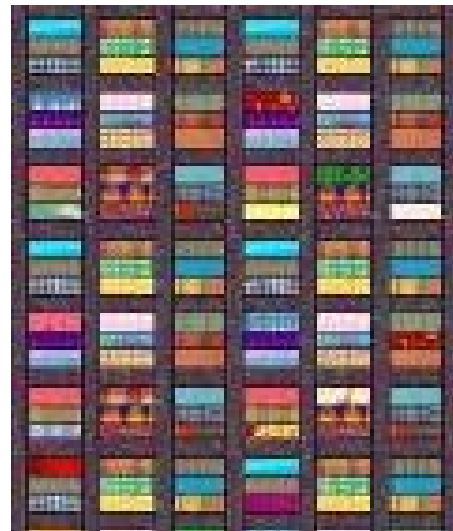
Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam (make sure you double-check this by measuring!), sew together the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, making sure the black strip is on the top. Press seams toward the darker colors.

(Black strip)
Your strip 1
Your strip 2
Your strip 3

Then, sew the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " black strip on the left side. Press seam toward the black.

When the blocks are pieced together they form a fun scrappy quilt!



If you are going to make a second block for our community project quilt, mix it up by using **white** fabric from your stash instead of the black top and side pieces.
