A big thank you to all of you that volunteered at the Quilt Show, we couldn't have done it without you.

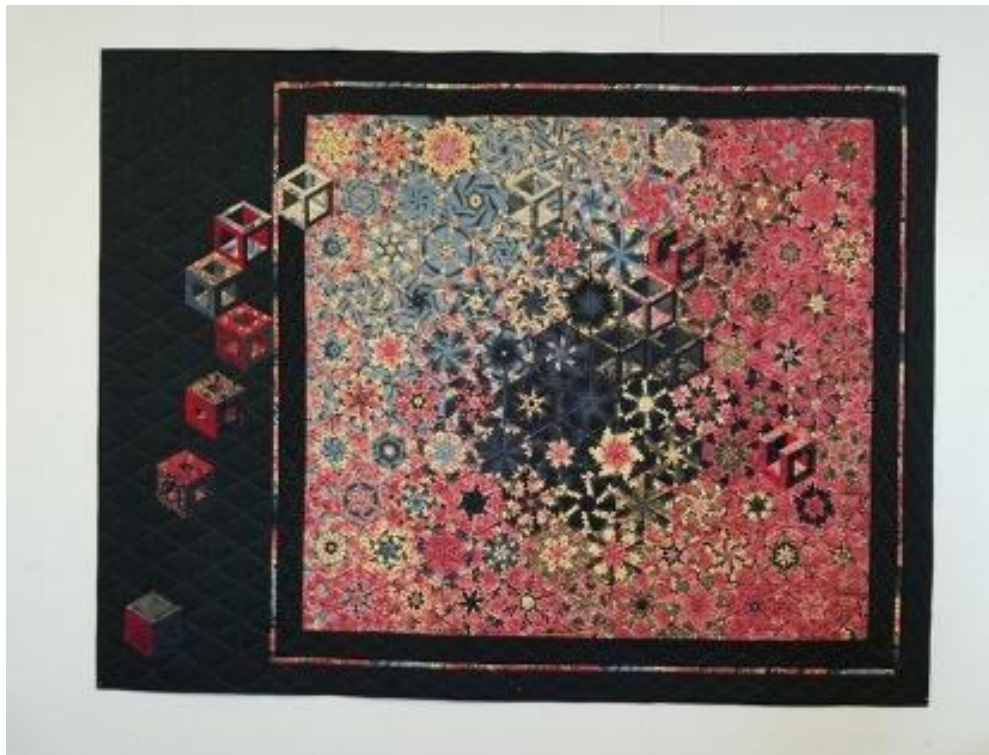
