What other information would you like to share about this activity?	They'd all like the beds to be a little larger than the 14"x 14". I've said this a few times at meetings, but the beds are usually made using pillowcases, so they remain smallish. The Coast Cat Project doesn't want them unless they need them, and they don't reach out to get them. I called/went by a number of times and they want them in the Spring, but in the Spring, they don't really want them!!
