### **Changes to Bylaws - Vote at the September Meeting \* Sharon L.**

The Board is proposing the following changes to the bylaws: (1) Every mention of Ocean Wave Quilters in the bylaws will be changed to Ocean Wave Quilters, Inc., since that is our official name since we incorporated as a 501(c)3 California corporation. (2) In ARTICLE 4: ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP DUES, Section 2 (Which reads "First-Time members joining after December 31 will pay 1/2 of yearly dues for the remainder of the year") will be moved to Section 3, and a new Section 2 will be added as follows: "Dues received after August 1 shall be assessed a late fee; amount to be determined each year by the Board."

Per the bylaws, this was discussed at the August General Meeting, is being published here in the newsletter, and will be voted on at the September General Meeting.

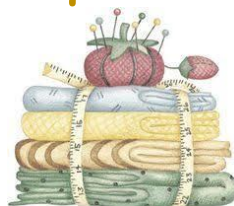
