1. We will have the windows and door open for ventilation, so bring a jacket or warm sweater.
2. We will space chairs as best we can to provide social distance.

4. Bring your own snack and beverage - there will not yet be a potluck table. (Someday, we hope!)

Tip of the Month

Have you ever had your pressure foot go wonky to the right when sewing over thick seams? I certainly have! I have pushed with tools like the Purple Thang and pulled. Never seems to work well. Still wonky with impossibly tiny stitches.

So, try adjusting the pressure foot down pressure! Ease up on this pressure so the foot is not pressing down so hard. Many machines nowadays have a setting where you can change this. It does help going over thick seams! Sadly, not all machines have this feature, but it is useful for thick fabrics and those pesky thick seams.

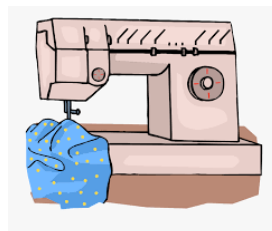
