What makes a good quilter? Of course, you need good tools like a sharp rotary cutter, accurate seams (1/4" or scant"), consistency, and practice. So, you say — what's missing? I put confidence at the top of the list. All this leads to confidence in yourself to tackle the most daunting quilting design. Every quilt design builds on all of the skills you accumulate just by making a variety of quilt blocks. So, variety leads to confidence which leads to the confidence to tackle — circles!
