26th Fort Bragg Quilt Show Entries Now Being Accepted – Sharon L.

We are ready to accept your entries to the June 25-26, 2022, quilt show! Fingers crossed that all goes well and the show will happen this year!

There are 2 ways you can enter: On-line and on paper. If you enter on-line, the fee is \$15 for the first 3 entries, \$5 for each additional entry. If you enter on paper, the fee is \$25 for the first 3 entries, \$5 for each additional entry. Both on-line and paper forms can be found on our website: oceanwavequilters.com, click on the Fort Bragg Quilt Show tab, and click on the links you'll find. Paper forms can also be picked up at Sew 'n Sew. Deadline for returning by either method is June 1, 2022. No late entries will be accepted.

PLEASE NOTE: We may limit the number of entries accepted per quilter, depending on how many entries we receive. (We know that you haven't entered any quilts in 2 years, and you have piles of them waiting in your closets, but there is only so much space at Dana Gray!) We are asking that you prioritize your entries, letting us know the ones you most want to have accepted. We may also limit the number of entries accepted per quilter to be judged. (We have two judges this year, but there are only so many hours in the day!) So, we are asking that you also prioritize the quilts you want to have judged.

JUST A REMINDER OF SOME OF THE RULES:

QUILT SLEEVE: **ALL quilts** – regardless of size – must have a 4" wide sleeve **stitched** down (no pins, please) along the top and bottom of the sleeve on the back for hanging.

QUILT LABEL: All quilts must have the exhibitor's name and address on the back. Please use the label attached to the entry form. Stitch or safety pin (pin at all corners) the label to the lower right corner on the back of the quilt. Do not use straight pins. Please bring your entry folded with the label showing. (Make sure your entry form and quilt label match.)

QUILT DROP-OFF: Quilts must be received at Sew 'n Sew at 890 N. Franklin Street, Fort Bragg on Tuesday, June 21st or Wednesday, June 22nd, between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm. Late entries will be refused. **We will be checking your quilt in this year, so please expect a short wait.** Your quilt receipt, label (if requested), show pin and show entry wristband will be given to you at that time.

QUILT RETURN: Quilts must be picked up on Sunday, June 26th between 5:00 pm and 6:00 pm in the foyer of Dana Gray Elementary School. **NO QUILTS WILL BE RELEASED EARLY. NO EXCEPTIONS.** To avoid confusion and losses, no items will be released until all quilts have been taken down. No article will be released without presentation of a receipt signed by the recipient.
