### INFORMATION FOR ENTRIES

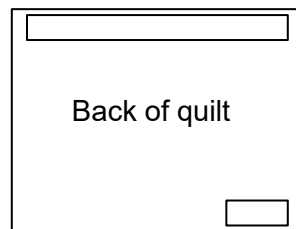
The Fort Bragg Quilt Show is an indoor show open to all quilters. Entries must not have been previously displayed in this show. We MAY limit the number of entries per quilter to 4, depending upon the space in our venue. (You may enter more, indicating the priority of each entry; your entry fee will not be refunded if your quilts are not displayed. You will be notified in early June if any of your quilts will not be displayed.)

We MAY limit quilts to be judged to 2 per quilter. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place ribbons may be awarded in each category. If a category has 3 or fewer entries, ribbons may not be awarded.

**ENTRY FEE:** If entry is done on-line (oceanwavequilters.com – click on Fort Bragg Quilt Show tab and scroll down) - \$15 for up to 3 entries; \$5 for each additional entry. If entry is done on paper - \$25 for up to 3 entries; \$5 for each additional entry. This fee includes one admission to the show and is non-refundable. Entry forms must be submitted on-line or postmarked by June 1. Your entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been received. MAIL A CHECK PAYABLE TO **FORT BRAGG QUILT SHOW** TO PO BOX 2687, FORT BRAGG, CA 95437.

**QUILT SLEEVE:** ALL quilts – regardless of size – must have a 4” wide sleeve stitched down (no pins, please) along the top and bottom of the sleeve on the back for hanging.

**QUILT LABEL:** All quilts must have the exhibitor’s name and address on the back. Please use the label attached to the entry form. Stitch or safety pin (pin at all corners) the label to the lower right corner on the back of the quilt. Do not use straight pins. Please bring your entry folded with the label showing. (Make sure your entry form and quilt label match.)

**IMPORTANT:** Dimensions of the quilt are to be rounded up to the nearest inch. Measure accurately, as this determines the size of the frame we reserve for you. Measurements are to be included on both the entry form and on the label.

**QUILT DROP-OFF:** Quilts must be received at Sew ‘n Sew at 890 N. Franklin Street, Fort Bragg on **Tuesday, June 20<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday, June 21<sup>st</sup> between the hours of 10 am and 2 pm.** Late entries will be refused. We will be checking your quilt in this year, so please expect a short wait. Your quilt receipt, label (if requested), show pin and show entry wristband will be given to you at that time.

**QUILT RETURN:** Quilts must be picked up on Sunday, June 25<sup>th</sup> between 5:00 pm and 6:00 pm in the foyer of Dana Gray Elementary School. **NO QUILTS WILL BE RELEASED EARLY. NO EXCEPTIONS.** To avoid confusion and losses, no items will be released until all quilts have been taken down. No article will be released without presentation of a receipt signed by the recipient.

**Art:** Quilt can be a pictorial of a person, place, thing or animal, generally intended to hang on the wall, can include textural elements, mixed media, painting, dyeing, materials other than fabric, etc.

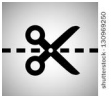
